





The graph above shows the average number of vacation days the workers received and the days they actually used in five countries last year. ① U.S. workers received the least granted vacation days among the five countries, an average of 12 days, of which they used only 10. ② On average, U.K. workers received seven more vacation days than Canadian workers. ③ Also, the average number of granted vacation days of U.K. workers was more than twice that of U.S. workers. ④ While the Japanese workers were granted 15 days off, they actually used less than half of them. ⑤ The average vacation days French workers received were more than the combined days Canadian and Japanese workers received.

As we look toward a future of more renewable energy dependency, having reliable energy storage to back up wind and solar will be necessary for everything to run smoothly. (①) Lithium-ion batteries are great for gadgets and even cars, but on a larger scale they're too expensive and aren't very environmentally friendly. (②) Many researchers believe sodium-ion batteries are the answer because sodium is cheap and eco-friendly, but the major obstacle to advancing these batteries has been a very short life. (③) The wood is able to withstand the swelling and contracting of the anode and allows the battery to survive more than 400 charge cycles. (④) At the end of the charging cycles, the wood is wrinkled, but still intact. (⑤) Computer models show that those wrinkles relax the stress in the battery during charging and recharging, creating a flexible and long-lasting battery.

While most of us assume that “use-by date” is synonymous with “expiration date,” those numbers have nothing to do with food safety and actually aren’t under any federal regulation at all. “Use-by” dates are set by the manufacturers and only indicate by what date the product should be used for “peak quality.” Once a product has passed its “use-by” date, most consumers will throw it out, incorrectly concluding that the product is expired and therefore no longer good to use. And what do we do when we’ve run out of a product? Buy more, of course.

Unfortunately, misunderstanding over these “use-by” dates leads to a lot of food waste. A research shows that almost 50 percent of consumers don’t understand “use-by” dates on food labels and that up to 20 percent of food waste is linked to this misunderstanding. Currently infant formula is the only product whose “use-by” date is regulated by the United States Department of Agriculture. As it doesn’t look like regulation of these dates will receive attention anytime soon, it’s up to you to be a smart shopper. Use your common sense (and new-found knowledge) to determine whether or not a food product is _____.

When you watch a baseball game, you can quickly tell by the umpire’s gestures if the pitch was a ball or a strike. What would baseball be without hand signals for verbally called “ball” or “strike”? William Hoy, one of the deaf major league baseball players, has been widely credited with creating the hand signals that are still used in baseball today.

(B)

Thanks to the umpire’s signals, the coach’s call signals, and such supportive gestures from the crowds, Hoy went on to play for several different major league teams as an outfielder for fifteen years. It is amazing to see a deaf person bring so much history into baseball. Hoy ended his major league career in 1902 and he died in 1961 at the age of 99. Sadly, (a) he has never been put in the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown. But he was one of the great pioneers of baseball.

(C)

Soon, the coach was also signaling the opposing team’s balls and strikes to Hoy when (b) he played outfield. Gradually, hand signals became common use in baseball among the players, coaches, and umpires. He even inspired a sort of sign language in the crowds. With Hoy being such a loved player, the crowds would jump up and wave their arms to cheer for (c) him when he made a great play.

Hoy was born in Ohio, on May 23, 1862. Due to an illness in his childhood, he lost his hearing. He graduated from the Ohio School for the Deaf and started his professional career in 1886 in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. When (d) he started his baseball career, the umpire shouted all the calls.
