ANN: 안녕하십니까? 2011학년도 9월 고1 전국연합학력평가 외국어영역 듣기 및 말하기 평가 안내방송입니다. 잠시 후 2011학년도 9월 고1 전국연합학력평가 3교시 외국어영역 듣기 및 말하기 평가 방송을 시작하겠습니다. 수험생 여러분은 편안한 마음으로 방송에 귀를 기울여 주시고 감독 선생님께서는 스피커의 음량을 알맞게 조절해 주십시오. 수험생 여러분은 답안을 작성하기 전에 반드시 답안지 왼쪽 해당란에 성명, 수험번호를 정확하게 기입하고 표기하였는지 확인하시기 바랍니다. 듣기 및 말하기 평가 문제는 1번부터 17번까지입니다. 방송을 잘 듣고 문제지에 있는 다섯 개의 답지 중에서 맞는 답 하나만 골라 답안지 해당란에 바르게 표기하십시오.

ANN: 그러면 지금부터 3교시 외국어 영역 듣기 및 말하기 평가를 시작하겠습니다. 1번부터 13번 문제까지는 듣고 답하는 문제이며, 14번부터 17번까지는 말하고자 하는 내용을 답지에서 골라 답하는 문제입니다. 방송을 잘 듣고 답을 하기 바랍니다. 듣는 내용은 한번만 방송됩니다.

ANN: 이제 듣기·말하기 문제가 끝났습니다. 18번부터는 문제지의 지시에 따라 답을 하기 바랍니다.

1. 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 제작할 티셔츠를 고르시오.

W: Daniel! I'm outlining the design for the T-shirt. Can you help me?

M: T-shirt? You mean our class T-shirts for sports day?

W: Yes. I'm wondering about putting our class slogan "Dream High" on it.

M: With just the slogan, the T-shirts would look a little bit too simple.

W: Oh, you're right. And how about a square around the slogan?

M: I think a circle would be better.

W: Okay. Then, should we add our class number 3 on the end of one sleeve?

M: What about adding it at both ends?

W: One end would be better to give a strong impression. (*pause*) Is this okay?

M: Good. I like that.

2. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Hey, what are you looking at?

W: Hi, Chris. I'm checking the flight schedule for this weekend.

M: Flight schedule? Are you going somewhere?

W: Yeah, I'm going to visit my parents because I haven't seen them for ages.

M: You must be excited. But why the long face?

W: Well, it's because of my cat.

M: Why? What's wrong with your cat?

W: Nothing yet. But something might happen to her while I'm gone.

M: Aren't you taking her with you?

W: Last time, she was sick all the way. So, this time, I'm not travelling with her.

M: Who's taking care of her then?

W: I'm not sure yet. I'm still trying to find the best place for her.

3. 다음을 듣고, 남자가 하는 말의 주제로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Travel is one of life's great joys. But even the most carefully planned trip can be complicated by unexpected events. Things like lost luggage, cancelled flights, or a medical emergency can turn a relaxing vacation into an unpleasant experience. Travel insurance is designed to keep your travel on track. The goal of this is to save you money, safeguard your journey, and make your vacation memorable. Don't forget to talk to your travel agent so you can choose the insurance that best meets your travel needs.

4. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 남자를 위해 할 일로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: Mom, I'm worried about my math exam.

W: How about asking Jenny for help? You said she's the best at math.

M: Jenny always helps me, but I didn't have enough time to study.

W: What are you going to do, then?

M: I'm going to study math tomorrow morning. Can you help me, Mom?

W: Don't worry. Do you want me to wake you up or set the alarm clock for you?

M: No. Just play the radio loud at 5 o'clock so that I don't go back to sleep.

W: OK. I won't forget the radio.

M: Thank you, Mom.

5. 대화를 듣고, 남자가 한 달에 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

(Telephone rings.)

W: Hello, this is FAST.com. How may I help you?

M: I'd like to get an Internet connection installed at my apartment. How much will it cost?

W: The installation is free and the monthly fee is 50 dollars.
