제 3 교시 영 어 듣기 대본

1번부터 12번까지는 듣고 답하는 문제입니다. 녹음 내용을 잘 듣고, 물음에 답하기 바랍니다.  
내용은 한 번만 들려줍니다.

1. 대화를 듣고, 남자가 묘사하는 그림을 고르시오.

W: Wow, are you drawing a sketch for your art class?  
M: Yes, it's due next week.  
W: Hmm, I see sunflowers in the vase. Great! Are you going to draw something else other than them?  
M: Yes, let me give you a brief description.  
W: Oh, thanks.  
M: On the table, there is a vase full of sunflowers. And there is a small basket next to the vase. The basket has two pumpkins inside it. And lastly, there are several apples in front of the vase.  
W: Wow. That will look great!

2. 다음을 듣고, 소녀에 대해 언급하지 않은 것을 고르시오.

W: Hello, shoppers! May I have your attention, please? We have a lost girl named Jane who was found in the sporting goods section of our store. She is looking for her parents. She's five years old. Her hair is long and curly. She's wearing a pink shirt and yellow pants. If Jane's parents are listening to this announcement, please come to the information center near the main entrance. Thank you.

3. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 설명하고 있는 것으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Yesterday, my father bought this device for my mother as her birthday present. Because she is bad with directions, she often gets lost when she drives to new places. From now on she doesn't need to worry about that. She can just type in the name of a place on the screen, then it will show her how to get to her destination. She also won't be bored while driving because she can listen to a lively voice giving her directions.

4. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 전화한 목적을 고르시오.

M: White Castle Restaurant. How may I help you?  
 W: I'd like to make a reservation for three at 5:30.  
 M: I'm sorry, but we're all booked up at that time.  
 W: How about 6:30 then?  
 M: 6:30 is good. Can I please have your name and your phone number?  
 W: This is Jessica Park and my number is 010-5434-4321.  
 M: Ok. Which do you prefer, smoking or non-smoking?  
 W: Non-smoking, please.

5. 대화를 듣고, 여자의 심정으로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

W: Wake up, Tom. It's time for school.  
 M: Mom, I'm so tired. Let me sleep for five more minutes.  
 W: You have to get up and get ready for school.  
 M: I know, but just five more minutes.  
 W: I can't let you go back to sleep, because you won't wake up in five minutes.  
 M: I promise I will wake up in five minutes.  
 W: You still need to eat breakfast, take a shower, and get dressed.  
 M: I know that, and I can do all that in time when I wake up.  
 W: I don't want you to be late for school today.  
 M: Mom, I'm not going to be late!

6. 대화를 듣고, 여자가 지불할 금액을 고르시오.

M: Did you enjoy your meal?  
 W: Yes, we did.  
 M: Okay, you had two small pizzas, one cream pasta and three glasses of orange juice. Is that right?  
 W: Yes, that's right. How much is it?  
 M: A pizza is ten dollars and a pasta costs twenty dollars. So in total, it's forty dollars.  
 W: What about the orange juice?  
 M: We provide orange juice for free.  
 W: That's great. I think I have a five dollar off coupon with me.  
 M: Okay, that works.  
 W: How much is the total with discount? Here is my card.

7. 대화를 듣고, 남자가 마지막으로 전화를 받을 시각을 고르시오.

W: Front desk. May I help you?  
 M: This is Tom in room 301. Can you give me a wake-up call tomorrow?  
 W: Certainly. When would you like the call?  
 M: I need two wake-up calls, if you don't mind, one at 7 and the other at 7:15.  
 W: No problem. We'll call you tomorrow morning at 7, and again at 7:15.  
 M: On second thought, could you make the second call at 7:30 instead of 7:15?  
 W: Okay. Will there be anything else?  
 M: Not at the moment, thank you.

8. 대화를 듣고, 두 사람이 대화하는 장소로 가장 적절한 것을 고르시오.

M: How did you like your room? Did you sleep well?  
 W: The room was nice but I didn't get a good sleep.  
 M: Oh, are you okay?  
 W: No, not really. I think I'm getting sick. I guess long flight yesterday made me tired and sick.  
 M: Oh, no. Do you think you need to see a doctor?  
 W: Yeah, I'm afraid so. But I don't know where we can find a doctor here.  
 M: I think we should call the front desk to see if they can help us.  
 W: Oh, right. That sounds like a good idea.  
 M: And we bought a travel insurance yesterday before we departed, right?  
 W: Right. We did.  
 M: Great. I am going to call the front desk right now for help.

9. 대화를 듣고, 두 사람의 대화가 어색한 것을 고르시오.

① W: Would you mind if I open the window?  
 M: No, I don't. It is too hot here.  
 ② W: What did you think of her new dress?  
 M: I think it looked good on her.  
 ③ W: You've got a new laptop. Can I take a look?  
 M: Oh, look at that nice laptop.  
 ④ W: Math is too difficult for me. I don't know what to do with it.  
 M: Cheer up. I can help you with it.  
 ⑤ W: I'd like to have one Mickey Burger Combo Number 2.  
 M: For here or to go?

 M: I'll send a technician over to fix it.  
 W: How soon can he be here?
