





In addition to the body's natural defenses, individuals can fight back against microbial infection. Careful hand washing with soap after using the bathroom and before eating is a practical way to prevent the spread of microbes. Avoiding spoiled or undercooked foods is another way. Keeping cutting boards clean by washing with detergent and drying after each use prevents the boards from becoming bacterial breeding grounds. If possible, wash dishes in the dishwasher.
