However, some experts suggest that water pollution, acid rain, global warming, and increases in ultraviolet radiation as a result of the thinning ozone layer may all be playing a role. Recently, biologists have documented a serious drop in all seven native toad and frog species that inhabit the relatively pristine Yosemite region; three species have disappeared from the study area entirely. 

School Attainment and Undernourishment by Region



The graph above shows school attainment and undernourishment by region. ① On average, people complete only 3.3 years of school in sub-Saharan Africa and only 4.5 years in South Asia. ② These are the two subregions where hunger is most prevalent, so that 35 percent of people are undernourished in sub-Saharan Africa and 22 percent in South Asia. ③ In Latin America, people study in school for about 6 years and the percentage of the undernourished people is less than a third of that of sub-Saharan Africa. ④ People in East Asia study in school shorter than those in Near East and North Africa, but the percentage of people who are undernourished is the same. ⑤ Overall, we can say that the more people suffer from hunger and poverty, the less time they spend in school.
