White tea is the world's rarest tea as it can only be picked for a few weeks in any one year when the plants are very young. The new buds are plucked before they open, withered to allow the natural moisture to evaporate, and then dried. This method of processing keeps the white tea leaves closer to their natural state. White tea is distinguished by its delicate, soft taste and light color.
