1번 대화를 듣고, 남자가 구입할 화분을 고르시오.

W: Hello, how may I help you?

M: Hi. I'm looking for a pot.

W: Which do you prefer, a square top or round top?

M: I think these with the round top would go better with my other pots.

W: Then, how about this round one with both a leaf and the word 'GARDEN' on it? It's the bestseller.

M: Sorry, I don't like the word 'GARDEN'. I'll take the one with only a leaf on it.
