



The pie chart above shows the world consumption of cocoa in 2008 and 2009. ① People in Europe consumed the most cocoa, making up 49.32%. ② The United States and Non-U.S. North America had the second largest cocoa consumption, which was less than a quarter of the world's cocoa consumption. ③ When looking only at the United States, cocoa consumption was just over 20% followed by Asia and Oceania. ④ People in South America consumed more than three times the cocoa than those in Non-U.S. North America. ⑤ The lowest consumption of cocoa was observed in Africa, totaling 3.28%.

A series of experiments demonstrated that different group members made effort or free rode under different task conditions.
